MATERIAL

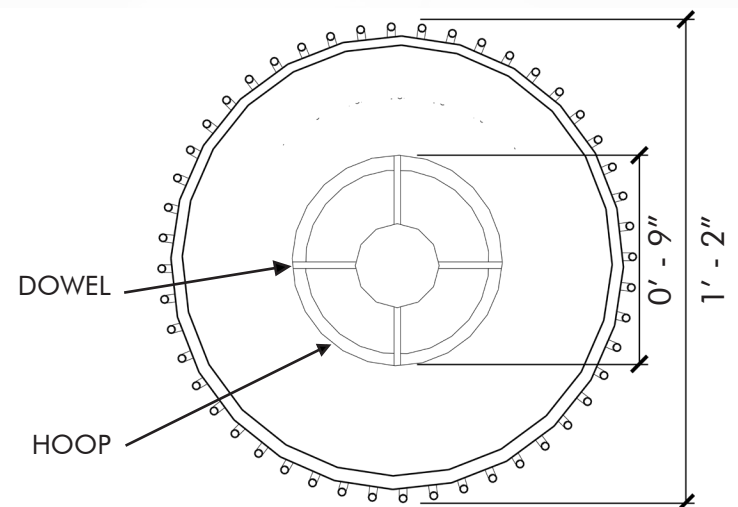
- MEINL 14" SYNTHETIC DJEMBE, SYNTHETIC HEAD (PATENTED), KENYAN QUILT
